Term	Easily Understood Language (6th Grade)
ABDOMEN	Belly
ABNORMAL UTERINE BLEEDING	Bleeding from the womb that is not normal
ABORTION	A surgery to end a pregnancy
ACANTHOSIS NIGRICANS	A condition when the skin starts to darken and get thicker
ACCESSORY TRAGUS	Extra skin on the outside of the ear
ACID MALTASE DEFICIENCY	A condition present from birth that disables the heart and muscles
ACID REFLUX	When acid from the stomach backs up into the throat and causes burning pain
ACIDOSIS	Too much acid in the body fluids
ACNE	A common skin problem that causes pimples
ACTINIC KERATOSIS	A thickening of the skin from too much sun
ACUPUNCTURE	A treatment that places tiny needles into the skin to help control pain
ACUPUNCTURIST	A provider (or healthcare worker) who places tiny needles into the skin to help control pain
ACUTE MYELOID LEUKEMIA (AML)	A type of cancer of the blood
ADENOID	Round pieces of tissue in the back of the throat
ADENOIDECTOMY	A surgery to take out the round pieces of tissue in the back of the throat
ADENOMYOSIS	Thickening of the womb that is not normal
ADENOSINE STRESS TEST	A test used to evaluate blood flow to the heart
AUTISM DIAGNOSTIC INTERVIEW (ADI-R)	A set of questions parents or caregivers answer about how the child talks and acts
ADRENAL GLAND	An organ in the body that makes chemicals the body needs to work right
ADRENOGENITAL SYNDROME	A group of conditions which cause the sex organs to grow larger than normal
ADRENOLEUKODYSTROPHY	A condition when the body cannot break down certain types of fats
ADVANCE DIRECTIVE	Notes that show the kind of healthcare a person wants when they cannot speak for themselves
AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR	An act that is violent and cannot be predicted
AGITATION	When a person is not able to relax and stay still
AIR MATTRESS	A special bed that helps prevent bed sores

<b>AIRWAY VEST CLEARANCE SYSTEM</b>	A vest hooked to a device that helps the lungs clear out mucus
<b>ALCOHOL SCREEN</b>	A test to determine if there is alcohol in the body
<b>ALCOHOLISM</b>	A long-term disease when a person has problems with alcohol use
<b>ALLERGY</b>	A reaction to something that may cause a rash, runny nose, or itchy eyes
<b>ALLERGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats people with reactions to things found in their surroundings
<b>ALLERGY FOOD PATCH TESTING</b>	A group of tests to see if a person has a reaction to certain foods
<b>ALLERGY INJECTIONS</b>	Shots to help a person stop reacting to things found in their surroundings
<b>ALLERGY SKIN TESTING</b>	A skin test to see if a person has a reaction to things found in their surroundings
<b>ALOPECIA</b>	Baldness or hair loss
<b>ALOPECIA AREATA</b>	Loss of small patches of hair
<b>ALPHA 1-ANTITRYPSIN DEFICIENCY</b>	A condition present at birth that can lead to liver and lung disease
<b>ALPHA FETOPROTEIN (CANCER SCREEN)</b>	A blood test to check for cancer
<b>ALPHA FETOPROTEIN (FETAL SCREEN)</b>	A test used to see if an unborn baby is normal
<b>ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE</b>	Changes in the brain that cause problems with memory and the way a person acts
<b>AMBIGUOUS GENITALIA</b>	When the sex organs are not clearly male or female
<b>AMBULATORY</b>	Able to walk
<b>AMENORRHEA</b>	When a female does not have regular periods
<b>AMPUTATION</b>	A surgery to remove a body part
<b>AMYOTROPHIC LATERAL SCLEROSIS (ALS)</b>	A disease of the nerves in the brain and spinal cord that control muscles
<b>ANAPHYLAXIS</b>	A severe reaction that is rapid and may cause death
<b>ANEMIA</b>	Low iron level in blood
<b>ANESTHESIOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who puts a person to sleep for a surgery
<b>ANEURYSM</b>	Area of weakness in the wall of an artery
<b>ANGINA</b>	Chest pain
<b>ANGIOEDEMA</b>	Swelling under the skin

<b>ANGIOGRAM</b>	A special picture of blood vessels
<b>ANGIOPLASTY</b>	A procedure to open blocked blood vessels of the heart
<b>ANKLE FOOT ORTHOSIS</b>	A brace to support the ankle and the foot
<b>ANKLE FUSION</b>	A surgery where ankle bones are joined together
<b>ANKYLOSING SPONDYLITIS</b>	Painful joint swelling that can cause the backbones to grow together
<b>ANODYNE THERAPY</b>	A treatment using a special light to decrease pain and swelling
<b>ANOMALY</b>	Not normal
<b>ANOREXIA</b>	Not eating due to a severe fear of gaining weight
<b>ANTERIOR CRUCIATE LIGAMENT (ACL) TEAR</b>	A tear in tissue that holds the kneecap in place
<b>ANTIBIOTICS</b>	Drugs that kill bacteria
<b>ANTICOAGULATION</b>	The use of drugs to thin blood and keep it from clotting too easily
<b>ANUS</b>	The opening where stool exits the body
<b>ANXIETY</b>	A feeling of fear or stress
<b>AORTA</b>	The main blood vessel which carries blood from the heart to the body
<b>APHASIA</b>	Trouble speaking due to a brain injury
<b>APNEA</b>	A condition when a person stops breathing
<b>APNEA DOWNLOADS</b>	The notes from a machine that checks the heart rate and breathing
<b>APNEA MONITOR</b>	A machine that checks the heart rate and breathing
<b>APRAXIA</b>	Disorder of the brain and nervous system in which a person is unable to perform tasks or movements when asked
<b>AQUACEL SILVER DRESSING</b>	Large cloth to help a wound heal faster
<b>ARRHYTHMIA</b>	A heart beat that is not regular
<b>ARTERY</b>	A vessel that carries blood from the heart to the body
<b>ARTERIOSCLEROSIS</b>	A condition of hardening of blood vessels
<b>ARTERIOVENOUS MALFORMATION (AVM)</b>	A condition when blood vessels join in a way that is not normal
<b>ARTHEROSCLEROSIS</b>	A condition of hardening of blood vessels

<b>ARTHRITIS</b>	Painful joint swelling
<b>ARTHROCENTESIS</b>	A procedure to remove extra fluid from a joint
<b>ARTHROPLASTY</b>	A surgery to rebuild or replace a joint
<b>ARTHROSCOPY</b>	A special test using a camera to look inside a joint
<b>ARTHROTOMY</b>	A surgery to open a joint
<b>ARTICULATION DISORDER</b>	Trouble speaking because of problems with the tongue or lips
<b>ASCITES</b>	A condition causing fluid in the belly that is not normal
<b>ASPERGER'S SYNDROME</b>	A condition that affects a person's social skills
<b>ASPHYXIA</b>	A condition of not enough air to the body
<b>ASPIRATION</b>	The act of inhaling something harmful into the lungs
<b>ASTHMA</b>	A condition caused by narrowing of the large air pipes making it hard to breathe
<b>ASYMMETRICAL BREASTS</b>	One breast does not look like the other one
<b>ASYMPTOMATIC</b>	No sign of a medical problem
<b>ATOPIC DERMATITIS</b>	Skin that is itchy and scaly
<b>ATRIAL FIBRILLATION</b>	A heartbeat that is not normal
<b>ATRIOVENTRICULAR SEPTAL DEFECT (AVSD)</b>	A condition present from birth where there is no wall between the chambers of the heart
<b>ATROPHY</b>	A condition when a body part weakens
<b>ATTENTION DEFICIT DISORDER (ADD)</b>	A condition when a person cannot focus on a task for very long
<b>ATTENTION DEFICIT HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER (ADHD)</b>	A condition when a person cannot focus on a task or sit still for long
<b>AUDIOLOGY TEST</b>	An exam to check a person's hearing
<b>AUDITORY BRAINSTEM RESPONSE (ABR)</b>	A special test of the brain to check hearing
<b>AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER (ASD)</b>	A group of conditions when a person has poor social skills and repeats actions
<b>AUTOIMMUNE</b>	A condition when the body attacks its own cells
<b>BACTERIA</b>	Germs
<b>BALANITIS</b>	Painful swelling of the head of the male sex organ
<b>BARIATRIC SURGEON</b>	A special doctor who does weight loss surgery
<b>BARIUM ENEMA</b>	A special x-ray of the colon and rectum

<b>BARIUM SWALLOW</b>	A special test to examine the throat and stomach
<b>BARRETT'S ESOPHAGUS</b>	Damage to the food pipe caused by stomach acid
<b>BATH SEAT</b>	A chair used to help keep a person safe while they take a bath
<b>BED WEDGE</b>	A piece of foam that raises a person's upper or lower body while in bed
<b>BEHAVIORAL ISSUE</b>	A problem with the way a person acts
<b>BEHAVIOR MODIFICATION</b>	Treatment to change the way a person acts
<b>BENIGN</b>	Not dangerous to a person's health
<b>BENIGN PROSTATIC HYPERTROPHY (BPH)</b>	An increase in size of a male sex gland
<b>BILATERAL MYRINGOTOMY WITH TUBES (BMT)</b>	A surgery to help drain fluid from inside the ears
<b>BILE</b>	A fluid made by the liver that digests fat
<b>BILE DUCTS</b>	The tubes that carry the fluid that digests fat
<b>BI-LEVEL POSITIVE AIRWAY PRESSURE (BIPAP) MACHINE</b>	A special device that helps a person breathe while sleeping
<b>BILIARY CIRRHOSIS</b>	A condition caused by too much fluid in the liver
<b>BILIBLANKET</b>	A special blanket to treat babies with yellow skin that is not normal
<b>BILIRUBIN</b>	A yellow substance found in blood
<b>BIOFEEDBACK</b>	A special treatment to help a person control their thinking or reactions
<b>BIOPHYSICAL PROFILE</b>	A test that measures the health of a baby during pregnancy
<b>BIOPSY</b>	A procedure to remove tissue for testing
<b>BIPOLAR DISORDER</b>	A condition causing big mood swings from happy to sad without reason
<b>BIRTH CONTROL</b>	Methods to keep a woman from having a baby
<b>BIRTH DEFECT</b>	A problem that a person is born with
<b>BLEPHAROPLASTY</b>	A surgery on an eyelid
<b>BLOOD GLUCOSE MONITOR</b>	A device that measures the amount of sugar in the blood
<b>BLOOD HISTOLOGY</b>	A test of the blood cells
<b>BLOOD PRESSURE MONITOR</b>	A device to measure blood pressure
<b>BONE GROWTH STIMULATOR</b>	A device that helps a broken bone heal faster

<b>BONE MARROW</b>	The soft and spongy center of the bone
<b>BONE SPUR</b>	A small jagged growth on a bone
<b>BRACHIAL PLEXUS</b>	A grouping of nerves
<b>BRACHIOPLASTY</b>	A surgery to remove extra skin from the upper arms
<b>BRACHYCEPHALY</b>	A head that is wider than normal
<b>BRADYCARDIA</b>	A heart rate less than 60 beats per minute
<b>BRANCHIAL CLEFT CYST</b>	A condition present from birth causing lumps in or near the neck
<b>BRCA (BREAST CANCER) TEST</b>	A test that checks for the risk of breast cancer
<b>BREAST AUGMENTATION</b>	A surgery to make breasts bigger
<b>BREAST ENGORGEMENT</b>	Breasts that are too full of milk
<b>BRIEFS</b>	Special underwear that helps protect the skin
<b>BRONCHIAL SPASM</b>	A problem breathing due to tightening of the large air pipes in the lungs
<b>BRONCHIECTASIS</b>	A permanent widening of the large air pipes in the lungs
<b>BRONCHIOLITIS</b>	Swelling of small air pipes in the lungs
<b>BRONCHITIS</b>	Swelling of the large air pipes in the lungs
<b>BRONCHOSCOPY</b>	A special test using a camera to look inside the lungs
<b>BRUIT</b>	A sound that is not normal made by blood flowing through a vessel
<b>BUNION</b>	A growth on the side of the big toe
<b>BUNIONECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove a growth on the side of the big toe
<b>CACHEXIA</b>	A condition of wasting away
<b>CAFE AU LAIT SPOT</b>	A light tan birthmark
<b>CALCULUS</b>	A stone that is formed in the body
<b>CALLUS</b>	Skin that has become thick or hard
<b>CANCER</b>	A group of conditions in which cells grow out of control and invade parts of the body
<b>CANDIDA</b>	A yeast infection
<b>CANTHOPLASTY</b>	A surgery on the eyelid
<b>CAPSULE ENDOSCOPY</b>	A test using small camera which is swallowed to look inside the body

<b>CARBUNCLE</b>	A large boil under the skin
<b>CARDIAC DYSRHYTHMIA</b>	An irregular heart beat
<b>CARDIAC ISCHEMIA</b>	Reduced blood flow to the heart
<b>CARDIAC REHABILITATION</b>	A program to help a person heal after heart surgery
<b>CARDIAC STRESS TEST</b>	A test used to evaluate blood flow to the heart during exercise
<b>CARDIOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats heart problems
<b>CARDIOMYOPATHY</b>	A long term condition that enlarges and weakens the heart
<b>CARDIOTHORACIC SURGEON</b>	A special doctor who operates on the heart and lungs
<b>CARDIOVASCULAR TELEMETRY</b>	A special device that tracks heartbeats from another location
<b>CAROTID ARTERY</b>	A blood vessel that supplies oxygen to the brain
<b>CARPAL TUNNEL SYNDROME</b>	A condition caused by pressure on a nerve in the wrist
<b>CARTILAGE</b>	The tissue that connects the bones in a joint
<b>CATARACT</b>	A cloudy film on the lens of the eye
<b>CATHETER ABLATION</b>	A treatment to stop heartbeats that are not regular
<b>CAUDA EQUINA</b>	Nerve roots at the end of the tail bone
<b>CELIAC SPRUE</b>	A condition when the body cannot digest grain
<b>CELLULITIS</b>	Swelling of tissue caused by an infection
<b>CEREBRAL</b>	Of the brain
<b>CEREBRAL ARTERY OCCLUSION</b>	The blood vessels to the brain are blocked
<b>CEREBRAL EMBOLISM</b>	A clot that blocks a blood vessel in the brain
<b>CEREBRAL INFARCTION</b>	A stroke
<b>CEREBRAL PALSY</b>	Brain damage while in the womb or during birth causing poor muscle control
<b>CEREBRAL VASCULAR ACCIDENT (CVA)</b>	A stroke
<b>CEREBROSPINAL FLUID (CSF)</b>	A liquid around the spinal cord and brain
<b>CEREBROVASCULAR DISEASE</b>	Damage to blood vessels in the brain
<b>CERVICAL FUSION</b>	A surgery to join bones in the neck
<b>CERVICAL SPINE</b>	Bones in the back of the neck
<b>CERVICAL SPINE EPIDURAL INJECTION</b>	A shot of drugs into the neck bones to stop pain

<b>CERVICAL SPONDYLOSIS</b>	A condition causing the breakdown of the neck bones
<b>CERVICAL STENOSIS</b>	Narrowing of the spaces between the neck bones
<b>CERVICAL TRACTION UNIT</b>	A device that stretches the neck
<b>CERVICALGIA</b>	Neck pain
<b>CERVIX</b>	Neck of the womb
<b>CHAIR LIFT</b>	A special chair that tilts to help a person stand up
<b>CHARCOT-MARIE-TOOTH DISEASE</b>	A group of conditions that affect the nerves outside the brain and spine
<b>CHEMOEMBOLIZATION</b>	A procedure to put in cancer-fighting drugs into a tumor
<b>CHEMOTHERAPY</b>	The use of strong drugs to kill cancer cells
<b>CHIROPRACTIC ADJUSTMENT</b>	A treatment done by a special doctor to line up the back bone
<b>CHIROPRACTOR</b>	A special doctor who works with the bones and joints
<b>CHOLANGIOGRAPHY</b>	A special picture of the tubes that carry the fluid that digests fat
<b>CHOLECYSTECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove the gallbladder
<b>CHOLECYSTITIS</b>	Swelling of the gallbladder causing pain
<b>CHOLELITHIASIS</b>	The condition of having a stone in the gallbladder
<b>CHOLESTEROL</b>	A type of fat in blood
<b>CHONDROMALACIA OF PATELLA</b>	The smooth tissue under the knee gets too soft to work right
<b>CHORDEE REPAIR</b>	A surgery to fix a curved male sex organ
<b>CHRONIC</b>	Long term
<b>CHRONIC AIRWAY OBSTRUCTION</b>	A long-term condition causing breathing problems due to narrow wind pipes
<b>CHRONIC CONSTIPATION</b>	A long-term condition causing problems passing stool
<b>CHRONIC INTERSTITIAL CYSTITIS</b>	A long-term condition causing swelling of the bladder wall
<b>CHRONIC KIDNEY DISEASE</b>	A long-term condition causing the kidneys to not work right



<b>CHRONIC OBSTRUCTIVE PULMONARY DISEASE (COPD)</b>	A group of conditions that makes breathing hard
<b>CHRONIC PAIN SYNDROME</b>	Long-term pain that worsens over time
<b>CHRONIC PROGRESSIVE DEMYELINATION</b>	A long-term disease that causes the covering of nerves to break down
<b>CHRONIC PYELONEPHRITIS</b>	A long-term kidney infection
<b>CICATRICIAL ECTROPION</b>	A condition when the eyelid pulls away from the eye
<b>CIRCUMCISION</b>	A surgery to remove the fold of skin that covers the male sex organ
<b>CIRRHOSIS</b>	A long-term liver disease caused by scar tissue
<b>CLOSED HEAD INJURY</b>	A brain injury caused by a blow to the head
<b>CLOSTRIDIUM DIFFICILE (C. DIFF)</b>	A germ in the bowel
<b>CLUB FOOT</b>	A condition from birth when a baby's foot is twisted out of shape
<b>COCHLEAR IMPLANT</b>	A small device put in the ear to help deaf people hear
<b>COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENT</b>	A condition that makes it hard to think and learn
<b>COLECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove all or part of the bowel
<b>COLITIS</b>	Swelling of the bowel
<b>COLON</b>	The large bowel
<b>COLON POLYP</b>	A growth in the large bowel
<b>COLONOSCOPY</b>	A special test to look inside the large bowel
<b>COLOSTOMY</b>	A surgery to create an opening in the large bowel
<b>COMMODE</b>	A toilet used at the bedside
<b>COMPRESSED NERVE</b>	Pressure on the nerve causing pain
<b>COMPRESSION FRACTURE</b>	Collapse of a bone in the spine
<b>COMPRESSION STOCKINGS</b>	Special socks that are worn to help blood flow through the legs
<b>COMPUTERIZED TOMOGRAPHY (CT) ANGIOGRAPHY</b>	A special picture of blood vessels
<b>COMPUTERIZED TOMOGRAPHY (CT) SCAN</b>	Special pictures of the inside of the body
<b>CONCENTRATOR</b>	A device that provides oxygen
<b>CONCUSSION</b>	A small brain injury caused by a blow to the head
<b>CONGENITAL</b>	A condition a person is born with
<b>CONGENITAL HEART DISEASE</b>	Heart problem present at birth

<b>CONGENITAL HEREDITARY MUSCULAR DYSTROPHY</b>	A condition from birth that causes muscle weakness
<b>CONGENITAL TALIPES EQUINOVARUS</b>	A condition from birth when a baby's foot is twisted out of shape
<b>CONGESTIVE HEART FAILURE (CHF)</b>	A long-term condition when the heart cannot pump enough blood to other organs
<b>CONJUNCTIVITIS</b>	A condition due to swelling of the lining of the eye
<b>CONSTIPATION</b>	Problems passing stool
<b>CONSULTATION</b>	An office visit to discuss a person's care
<b>CONTINUOUS PASSIVE MOTION (CPM) MACHINE</b>	A device to help move a joint after surgery
<b>CONTINUOUS POSITIVE AIRWAY PRESSURE (CPAP)</b>	A device that helps with breathing while asleep
<b>CONTINUOUS POSITIVE AIRWAY PRESSURE (CPAP) HEADGEAR</b>	A head piece for the device that helps with breathing while asleep
<b>CONTRACEPTION</b>	A way to stop a woman from getting pregnant
<b>CONTRACTURE</b>	A long-term condition when a muscle freezes
<b>CONTROLLED ANKLE MOTION (CAM) WALKER</b>	A special brace used to support the lower leg
<b>CONVENIENCE ITEM</b>	Something to make an activity easier
<b>CONVULSIONS</b>	Severe muscle movements that cannot be controlled
<b>CORN</b>	Skin that has become thick or hard on the toes
<b>CORNEAL DYSTROPHY</b>	A condition causing the clear cover of the eye to be cloudy
<b>CORNEAL TRANSPLANT</b>	The clear cover of the eye is replaced by eye tissue from another person
<b>CORONARY ARTERY DISEASE (CAD)</b>	A long-term condition causing blood vessels in the heart to become partly blocked
<b>CORONARY ATHEROSCLEROSIS</b>	A long-term condition causing blood vessels in the heart to harden
<b>COSMETIC TREATMENT</b>	Care to improve a person's looks
<b>COSTOCHONDRITIS</b>	Painful swelling of the muscles between the ribs
<b>COWDEN SYNDROME</b>	A condition from birth that causes many small growths that are not cancerous

<b>C-PEPTIDE</b>	A protein made by the body that helps carry sugar into cells
<b>CRANIAL BANDING</b>	A head piece used to shape a baby's head
<b>CRANIAL MOLDING ORTHOSIS</b>	A head piece used to shape a baby's head
<b>CRANIAL REMOLDING HELMET</b>	A head piece used to shape a baby's head
<b>CRANIAL VAULT ASYMMETRY</b>	A person's skull is not a normal shape
<b>CRANIOTOMY</b>	A surgery where the skull is opened
<b>CROHN'S DISEASE</b>	A long-term condition causing painful swelling from the mouth through the large bowel
<b>C-TELOPEPTIDE (CTX)</b>	A special lab test to check bone mass
<b>CUBITAL TUNNEL SYNDROME</b>	A condition caused by pressure on a nerve in the elbow
<b>CUSTODIAL CARE</b>	A service to help with the daily activities
<b>CUSTOM</b>	Made specially for a person
<b>CUSTOM ORTHOTICS</b>	Shoe inserts that are made specially for a person
<b>CYSTIC FIBROSIS</b>	A condition that causes the lungs to be filled with thick, sticky mucus
<b>CYSTITIS</b>	Swelling of the bladder
<b>CYSTOCELE</b>	A condition that causes the bladder to bulge into the birth canal
<b>CYSTOSCOPY</b>	A special test to look inside of the bladder
<b>CYST</b>	A closed sac growing in the body that is not normal
<b>DAYTIME SOMNOLENCE</b>	A condition causing a person to be very sleepy in the day
<b>DEBRIDEMENT</b>	A treatment to remove damaged tissue to help healing
<b>DECUBITUS ULCER</b>	A bed sore
<b>DEEP VEIN THROMBOSIS (DVT)</b>	A blood clot in the leg
<b>DEFORMITY</b>	A body part that is not of normal shape
<b>DEGENERATIVE DISC DISEASE (DDD)</b>	The wearing down of the gel pads between the back bones
<b>DEGENERATIVE JOINT DISEASE (DJD)</b>	A group of long-term conditions causing the joints in the body to break down
<b>DELAYED MILESTONE</b>	A condition when a child is slower to learn tasks than other children the same age

<b>DEMENTIA</b>	A long-term condition that causes loss of the ability to think
<b>DEPRESSION</b>	Long periods of sadness
<b>DE QUERVAIN'S TENOSYNOVITIS</b>	A condition causing pain and swelling in the thumb
<b>DERMATITIS</b>	Swelling of the skin
<b>DERMATOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats problems of the skin
<b>DERMATOMYOSITIS</b>	A condition that causes weak muscles and a skin rash
<b>DERMATOPHYTOSIS</b>	Ringworm
<b>DEVELOPMENT</b>	How the body grows
<b>DEVELOPMENTAL APHASIA</b>	A long-term condition causing problems talking due to brain damage
<b>DEVELOPMENTAL ASSESSMENT</b>	A test to see how well a child is learning and growing
<b>DEVELOPMENTAL DELAY</b>	A condition when a child learns and grows slower than other condition their age
<b>DEVELOPMENTAL PEDIATRICIAN</b>	A special doctor who treats children who learn and grow slower than normal
<b>DEVELOPMENTAL TESTING</b>	A special exam to see how well a child is learning and growing
<b>DEVIATED NASAL SEPTUM</b>	A condition in which the wall in the middle of the nose is not straight
<b>DEXTROCARDIA</b>	A condition where the heart is on the right side of the chest instead of the left
<b>DIABETES</b>	A long-term condition that causes too much sugar in blood
<b>DIABETIC NEUROPATHY</b>	Nerve damage caused by high levels of sugar in blood
<b>DIALYSIS</b>	A treatment used to clean blood
<b>DIAPER</b>	Special underwear that helps protect the skin
<b>DIARRHEA</b>	Watery, loose stool
<b>DIGESTIVE TRACT</b>	The body parts from the mouth to the opening where stool comes out
<b>DILATION AND CURETTAGE (D &amp; C)</b>	A surgery to scrape the lining of the womb
<b>DISC</b>	The gel pad between the back bones
<b>DISC DECOMPRESSION</b>	A surgery to lessen pressure of the gel pads between the back bones

<b>DISCECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove part of a gel pad between the back bones
<b>DOPPLER</b>	A moving picture of the inside of the body
<b>DORSAL COLUMN STIMULATOR</b>	A device placed near the backbone used to treat long-term pain
<b>DOWN SYNDROME</b>	A condition present at birth that causes a wide face and slow learning
<b>DROWSINESS</b>	Sleepiness
<b>DRY EYE SYNDROME</b>	A condition of not enough tears in the eyes
<b>DUODENAL ULCER</b>	A sore in the upper part of the small bowel
<b>DUPLEX DOPPLER TEST</b>	A test to show how blood moves through blood vessels
<b>DUPLEX ULTRASOUND</b>	A test to show how blood moves through blood vessels
<b>DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT</b>	items or devices to help a person with a health problem
<b>DYNASPLINT</b>	A special brand of brace that will gently stretch muscles
<b>DYSARTHRIA</b>	A long-term condition causing speech problems after the brain has been injured
<b>DYSCHROMIA</b>	A change in the color of the skin
<b>DYSFUNCTIONAL UTERINE BLEEDING (DUB)</b>	Bleeding from the womb that is not normal
<b>DYSLEXIA</b>	A condition that makes it hard to read
<b>DYSLIPIDEMIA</b>	High levels of fat in blood
<b>DYSMENORRHEA</b>	More pain than is normal during a woman's period
<b>DYSPEPSIA</b>	Upset stomach after eating
<b>DYSPHAGIA</b>	A problem swallowing
<b>DYSPHONIA</b>	A problem with normal speaking
<b>DYSPNEA</b>	Shortness of breath
<b>DYSPRAXIA</b>	A condition that causes a child to be clumsy
<b>DYSURIA</b>	Trouble emptying the bladder
<b>ECCHYMOSIS</b>	A bruise
<b>ECHOCARDIOGRAM</b>	A test where pictures are taken of the heart
<b>ECTODERMAL DYSPLASIA</b>	A condition when the skin, hair and nail growth is not normal

<b>ECZEMA</b>	A condition that causes red itchy skin
<b>EDEMA</b>	Swelling caused by too much fluid in the body
<b>ELECTRIC BREAST PUMP</b>	A machine that collects breast milk
<b>ELECTRICAL STIMULATION</b>	The use of electric currents to make muscles stronger
<b>ELECTROCARDIOGRAM (EKG)</b>	A test to record heart activity
<b>ELECTROENCEPHALOGRAM (EEG)</b>	A test to record brain activity
<b>ELECTROMYOGRAPHY (EMG)</b>	A test to record muscle activity
<b>ELECTROPHYSIOLOGICAL TEST</b>	A test to record heart activity
<b>EMOLLIENT</b>	A cream or lotion to help with skin problems
<b>EMPHYSEMA</b>	A condition that causes trouble breathing
<b>END STAGE RENAL DISEASE (ESRD)</b>	A condition when the kidneys do not work well
<b>ENDOCARDITIS</b>	Inflammation of the inside lining of the heart chambers and heart valves
<b>ENDOCRINOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats gland problems
<b>ENDOMETRIAL ABLATION</b>	A procedure to remove the lining of the womb
<b>ENDOMETRIAL HYPERPLASIA</b>	A thicker than normal lining of the womb
<b>ENDOMETRIOSIS</b>	A condition where the tissue that lines the womb grows outside the womb
<b>ENDOSCOPY</b>	A test using a scope to look inside a part of the body
<b>ENDOVENOUS LASER ABLATION</b>	A treatment to remove damaged veins using a special light
<b>ENTERAL THERAPY</b>	Liquid food given through a tube
<b>ENTERITIS</b>	Swelling of the small bowel
<b>EPIDURAL INJECTION</b>	A procedure to put drugs into the space between the back bones to block pain
<b>EPIGASTRIC PAIN</b>	Pain in the mid-stomach area
<b>EPILEPSY</b>	A condition caused by electric currents in the brain that are not normal
<b>EPWORTH SLEEPINESS SCALE</b>	A test used to see how sleepy a person is during the day
<b>EQUINUS FOOT DEFORMITY</b>	A foot problem that causes a person to walk on tiptoes
<b>ERECTILE DYSFUNCTION</b>	When a man is not able to keep the male sex organ firm

<b>ESOPHAGEAL REFLUX</b>	A condition that causes stomach acid to go into the throat and cause pain
<b>ESOPHAGEAL ULCER</b>	A sore in the food pipe
<b>ESOPHAGITIS</b>	The condition where the food pipe is swollen due to stomach acid
<b>ESOPHAGOGASTRODUODENOSCOPY (EGD)</b>	A test using a scope to look inside the body from the mouth to the small bowel
<b>ESOPHAGOSCOPY</b>	A test using a scope to look at the inside of the food pipe
<b>ESOPHAGUS</b>	Food pipe
<b>ESSURE</b>	A procedure to keep a woman from getting pregnant
<b>EVALUATION</b>	A group of tests done to tell a person what treatment is needed
<b>EXCISION</b>	A surgery to cut out something in the body
<b>EXOPHTHALMOS</b>	A condition that causes the eyes to bulge
<b>EXOSTOSIS</b>	A bony growth on the foot
<b>EXPRESSIVE LANGUAGE DISORDER</b>	A condition that causes a person to have trouble speaking
<b>FAILURE TO THRIVE</b>	A condition when a child has low weight for their age
<b>FALLOPIAN TUBES</b>	Small vessels that carry the egg cells to the womb
<b>FATIGUE</b>	Lack of energy
<b>FECAL INCONTINENCE</b>	a condition when a person leaks stool
<b>FEMUR FRACTURE</b>	a broken thigh bone
<b>FETAL ALCOHOL SYNDROME (FAS)</b>	a condition where a child has problems when the mother drank too much while pregnant
<b>FETUS</b>	An unborn baby
<b>FIBROADENOMA</b>	A lump in the breast
<b>FIBROMYALGIA</b>	A condition that causes muscle pain and weakness
<b>FLUOROSCOPY</b>	A moving picture of the inside of the body
<b>FOOD ALLERGY</b>	A reaction from eating certain foods that may cause a rash and swelling

<b>FOOT DROP</b>	A condition that causes problems lifting the front part of the foot
<b>FOOT PRONATION</b>	Is a condition where the foot turns outward at the ankle
<b>FORESKIN</b>	The fold of skin that covers the head of the male sex organ
<b>FRAGILE X SYNDROME</b>	A form of mental illness that may have been passed on by parents
<b>FRENULECTOMY</b>	A surgery to cut a piece of tissue from under the tongue
<b>FRENULUM</b>	The tissue that attaches the tongue to the mouth
<b>FUNCTIONAL CAPACITY EVALUATION</b>	A group of tests to see how well the body and muscles work
<b>FURUNCLE</b>	A boil or painful swelling of the skin
<b>GALLBLADDER</b>	The sac under the liver that holds the fluid for breaking down fats
<b>GALLSTONE</b>	A pebble in the sac under the liver that holds the fluid for breaking down fats
<b>GANGLION</b>	A hard sac filled with fluid on the wrist or fingers
<b>GANGRENE</b>	A condition caused by death of body tissue from lack of blood flow
<b>GASTRIC BYPASS SURGERY</b>	A surgery to help a person lose weight
<b>GASTRIC ULCER</b>	A sore in the lining of the stomach
<b>GASTRITIS</b>	Pain and swelling of the lining of the stomach
<b>GASTRODUODENITIS</b>	Swelling of the stomach and the small bowel
<b>GASTROENTEROLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats problems with the stomach or bowel
<b>GASTROESOPHAGEAL REFLUX DISEASE (GERD)</b>	A condition that causes stomach acid to go into the throat and cause pain
<b>GASTROINTESTINAL BLEEDING</b>	A loss of blood inside the body anywhere from the food pipe to the bowels
<b>GASTROPARESIS</b>	A condition that causes food to stay in the stomach longer than normal
<b>GASTROSTOMY</b>	A surgery to make an opening in the stomach
<b>GENERAL ANESTHESIA</b>	Drugs used to put a person to sleep
<b>GENERIC DRUG</b>	A medicine that has no brand name



<b>GENETIC TESTING</b>	A group of blood tests done to see what traits have been passed to a person from the parents
<b>GENETICS</b>	The study of how traits are passed from parents to their children
<b>GENETICIST</b>	A special doctor who studies how traits are passed from parents to their children
<b>GENITAL CONDYLOMA</b>	A condition that causes warts on the sex organs
<b>GENITAL HERPES</b>	A condition that causes sores on the sex organs
<b>GINGIVECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove part of the gums in the mouth
<b>GLAUCOMA</b>	A condition that causes increased pressure in the eye
<b>GLUCOSE TOLERANCE</b>	A test that measures the body's response to sugar
<b>GOUT</b>	A painful condition caused by crystals in the joint fluid
<b>GRANULOMA ANNULARE</b>	A condition that causes a rash of red ring-like spots on the feet or hands
<b>GROWTH HORMONE DEFICIENCY (GHD)</b>	A shortage of a chemical in the body that helps a person grow
<b>GROWTH HORMONE STIMULATION TEST</b>	A blood test that measures the chemical in the body that helps a person grow
<b>GYNECOMASTIA</b>	A condition when a male has breasts than are larger than normal
<b>HALLUX VALGUS CORRECTION</b>	A surgery to straighten the big toe
<b>HAMMER TOE</b>	A condition when a toe is bent at the middle joint
<b>HEARING AID</b>	A small device to help a person hear better
<b>HEART CATHETERIZATION</b>	A procedure to check for blockages in the heart
<b>HEART MURMUR</b>	An unusual sound heard during a heartbeat
<b>HEARTBURN</b>	A painful burning sensation in the chest
<b>HEEL SPUR</b>	A small growth of bone on the back of the foot
<b>HELICOBACTER PYLORI (H PYLORI) BACTERIA</b>	A germ that causes stomach problems
<b>HEMANGIOMA</b>	An unusual buildup of blood vessels in the skin
<b>HEMATEMESIS</b>	Vomiting blood
<b>HEMIPARESIS</b>	Weakness on one side of the body

<b>HEMIPLEGIA</b>	Loss of movement on one side of the body
<b>HEMODIALYSIS (HD)</b>	A treatment that uses a special machine to clean blood
<b>HEMOGLOBIN (HGB)</b>	The amount of red cells in blood
<b>HEMOGLOBIN A1C</b>	A test that measures the amount of sugar in blood over time
<b>HEMOPHILIA</b>	A problem when blood takes a long time to clot
<b>HEMORRHOIDS</b>	Swollen, painful veins where stool exits the body
<b>HEPATITIS C</b>	Swelling of the liver caused by an infection
<b>HEPATOCELLULAR CARCINOMA (HCC)</b>	Liver cancer
<b>HEPATOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats liver problems
<b>HERNIA</b>	A condition when an organ bulges through the muscle wall near it
<b>HERNIATED DISC</b>	A bulging of a gel pad between the bones in the spine
<b>HIATAL HERNIA</b>	A condition when part of the stomach bulges into the chest wall
<b>HIDA (HEPATOBIILIARY IMINODIACETIC ACID) SCAN</b>	A special test to measure the fluid from the liver to the small bowel
<b>HIP HEMIARTHROPLASTY</b>	A surgery to replace part of the hip
<b>HIRSCHSPRUNG’S DISEASE</b>	A condition from birth of the large bowel causing problems passing stool
<b>HIRSUTISM</b>	A condition causing too much hair growth in women that is not normal
<b>HIVE</b>	A raised, itchy area of skin
<b>HOLTER MONITOR</b>	A type of portable heart monitor
<b>HOME INFUSION</b>	A service to give medicine through a blood vessel to a person at home
<b>HORMONE</b>	A chemical made by a cell or organ to help the body work right
<b>HORMONE REPLACEMENT</b>	Drugs that act like chemicals made by cells or organs to help the body work right
<b>HOSPICE CARE</b>	End of life care
<b>HOYER LIFT</b>	A mobile device that can move a person from one place to another

<b>HUMAN LEUKOCYTE ANTIGEN (HLA) TYPING</b>	A blood test to see if a person is a match for a transplant
<b>HUMAN PAPILLOMAVIRUS (HPV)</b>	A virus that may lead to cancer
<b>HUMERUS</b>	A bone in the upper arm
<b>HUNTER SYNDROME</b>	A condition from birth that happens when a protein the body needs does not work right
<b>HYDROCEPHALUS</b>	Water on the brain
<b>HYPERACTIVITY</b>	When a person cannot sit still and moves around a lot
<b>HYPERAMMONEMIA</b>	High levels of amonia in blood
<b>HYPERBARIC OXYGEN THERAPY (HBOT)</b>	A treatment to increase the amount of oxygen in the blood for healing
<b>HYPERCALCEMIA</b>	High levels of calcium in blood
<b>HYPERCHOLESTEROLEMIA</b>	High levels of fat in blood
<b>HYPEREMESIS</b>	Severe vomiting
<b>HYPEREMESIS GRAVIDARUM</b>	Severe vomiting during pregnancy
<b>HYPERGLYCEMIA</b>	High levels of sugar in blood
<b>HYPERKERATOSIS</b>	A thickening of the skin
<b>HYPERLIPIDEMIA</b>	High levels of fats in blood
<b>HYPERPARATHYROIDISM</b>	A condition that causes high levels of calcium in blood
<b>HYPERPHOSPHATEMIA</b>	High levels of phosphate in blood
<b>HYPERPIGMENTATION</b>	A condition that causes the skin to become darker
<b>HYPERPROLACTINEMIA</b>	High levels of a chemical in blood that fills a woman's breasts with milk
<b>HYPERPRONATION</b>	The inward turning of the foot
<b>HYPERSONNIA</b>	A condition that makes a person sleep too much
<b>HYPERTENSION</b>	High blood pressure
<b>HYPERTRIGLYCERIDEMIA</b>	High levels of fat in blood
<b>HYPERTROPIA</b>	A condition that causes an eye to turn in and up
<b>HYPOGLYCEMIA</b>	Low level of sugar in blood
<b>HYPOGONADISM</b>	A condition that causes the sex glands to not work right
<b>HYPOPIGMENTATION</b>	The loss of skin color

<b>HYPOPLASTIC LEFT HEART SYNDROME</b>	A condition which the left side of the heart does not develop right
<b>HYPOTHYROIDISM</b>	A condition when a gland in the neck does not work right
<b>HYPOTONIA</b>	A condition when the muscles are weak
<b>HYSTERECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove the womb
<b>HYSTEOSALPINGOGRAPHY</b>	A special picture of the womb and vessels that carry eggs
<b>HYSTEOSCOPY</b>	A special test to look inside the womb
<b>IMMUNE GLOBULIN</b>	A substance in the blood that fights illness
<b>IMMUNE SYSTEM</b>	The organs and cells that fight disease
<b>IMMUNODEFICIENCY</b>	A condition when the body cannot fight disease
<b>IMMUNOSUPPRESSION</b>	A drug or condition that keeps the body from fighting disease
<b>IMPETIGO</b>	A skin infection
<b>IMPLANT</b>	A man-made item that is placed inside of the body
<b>IMPOTENCE</b>	A condition when the male sex organ doesn't stay firm during sex
<b>INCONTINENCE</b>	A condition when urine or stool leaks
<b>INDIGESTION</b>	An upset stomach
<b>INFARCTION</b>	Tissue death caused by no blood supply
<b>INFECTION</b>	A condition when germs enter the body and cause disease
<b>INFLAMMATORY BOWEL DISEASE (IBD)</b>	A group of conditions that cause swelling of the large and small bowels
<b>INFUSION PUMP</b>	A device that gives a person a set amount of drugs into a blood vessel
<b>INFUSION THERAPY</b>	A treatment to give drugs or fluid through a vein
<b>INSOMNIA</b>	Problems falling and staying asleep
<b>INSULIN</b>	A chemical in blood which carries sugar into the cells
<b>INSULIN PUMP</b>	A small device in the body that gives a certain amount of a chemical
<b>INTERNATIONAL NORMALIZED RATIO (INR)</b>	A test to see how blood clots
<b>INTERNIST</b>	A special doctor who treats adults

<b>INTERSTITIAL CYSTITIS</b>	A long-term swelling of the bladder wall
<b>INTERVERTEBRAL DISC</b>	A gel pad between the bones of the spine
<b>INTOEING</b>	A condition when the feet turn inward
<b>INTRACRANIAL ARTERIOVENOUS MALFORMATION</b>	Problems with blood vessels in the brain
<b>INTRAOCULAR LENS</b>	A small plastic device placed in the eye
<b>INTRAVENOUS</b>	Into the vein
<b>INTRAVENOUS HYDRATION</b>	A treatment in which fluid is put into the veins
<b>INTRA-UTERINE DEVICE (IUD)</b>	A small device placed in the womb to keep a woman from getting pregnant
<b>JAUNDICE</b>	Yellowish color to the skin
<b>KELOID</b>	A thick, raised scar
<b>KERATITIS</b>	A condition caused by swelling of the front part of the eye
<b>KERATODERMA</b>	A condition that causes the skin to grow thick and hornlike
<b>KERATOPLASTY</b>	A surgery to replace the clear front tissue of the eye
<b>KERATOSIS</b>	Rough bumps on the skin
<b>KIDNEY</b>	The organ that cleans blood and makes urine
<b>KIDNEY STONES</b>	Pebbles in the organ that cleans blood and makes urine
<b>LABRAL TEAR</b>	A shoulder joint injury
<b>LAP BAND SURGERY</b>	A surgery that places a small ring around the stomach to help lose weight
<b>LAPAROSCOPY</b>	A procedure using a special scope to look inside the belly
<b>LARYNGOSCOPY</b>	A procedure using a special scope to look inside the throat
<b>LASER</b>	A special light used to cut or burn tissue
<b>LATERAL EPICONDYLITIS</b>	A condition that causes pain and swelling of the elbow
<b>LEARNING DISORDER</b>	A condition that makes it hard for a person to take in new information
<b>LEGG-CALVES-PERTHES DISEASE</b>	A condition where the thigh bone in the hip does not get enough blood causing it to die
<b>LESION</b>	Body tissue that is not normal

<b>LEUKEMIA</b>	A group of cancer types that affects the white blood cells
<b>LEUKOCYTOPENIA</b>	A low number of white cells in blood
<b>LEVEL II ULTRASOUND</b>	A special picture of a baby inside the womb using sound waves
<b>LIFT CHAIR</b>	A special chair that helps a person stand up
<b>LIGAMENT</b>	The tissue that connects the bones together
<b>LIPECTOMY</b>	A surgery to take off extra fat
<b>LIPOMA</b>	A growth made of fat
<b>LOW TESTOSTERONE</b>	A condition when a person has a low level of a male chemical
<b>LUMBAGO</b>	A condition when the lower back hurts
<b>LUMBAR DISCOGRAM</b>	A special x-ray of the lower back
<b>LUMBAR FACET SYNDROME</b>	A condition when the small joints in the lower back cause pain
<b>LUMBAR RADICULITIS</b>	A condition caused by painful swelling of the nerves in the lower back
<b>LUMBAR SACRAL ORTHOSIS</b>	A brace for the lower back
<b>LUMBAR SPINE EPIDURAL INJECTIONS</b>	Shots of a drug into the lower back to help relieve pain
<b>LUMBAR SPONDYLOSIS</b>	Wear and tear of the lower back bones
<b>LUMBAR SPRAIN</b>	An injury to the tissue that connects the bones in the lower back
<b>LUPUS</b>	A condition that causes the body to attack its own healthy organs
<b>LYMPH NODES</b>	Small oval sacs that store cells that fight infection
<b>LYMPHEDEMA</b>	When the small oval sacs that store cells that fight infection swell in the arms or legs
<b>LYMPHOMA</b>	A cancer of the small oval sacs that store cells that fight infection
<b>LYNCH SYNDROME</b>	Inherited cancer of the digestive tract
<b>MACROCEPHALY</b>	A condition when the head is larger than normal
<b>MAGNETIC RESONANCE ANGIOGRAM (MRA)</b>	A special picture of blood vessels
<b>MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING (MRI)</b>	A special picture of the inside of the body
<b>MALAISE</b>	Not feeling well

<b>MALARIA</b>	A condition caused by a bite from an infected mosquito
<b>MALIGNANT</b>	Cancerous
<b>MALNUTRITION</b>	When the body does not get enough nutrients
<b>MAMMOGRAM</b>	A special picture of the breast
<b>MAPLE SYRUP URINE DISEASE</b>	A condition from birth in which the body cannot break down some proteins
<b>MARFAN SYNDROME</b>	A condition from birth which affects muscles and nerves
<b>MASTECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove a breast
<b>MASTODYNIA</b>	Pain in the breast
<b>MASTOPEXY</b>	A surgery to lift or reshape breasts
<b>MELANOMA</b>	The most serious type of skin cancer
<b>MELASMA</b>	A brown area on the skin caused by too much sun
<b>MENIERE’S DISEASE</b>	A condition of the inner ear with dizziness and ringing
<b>MENOPAUSE</b>	When a woman stops having periods
<b>MENORRHAGIA</b>	Painful periods with heavy bleeding
<b>METABOLISM</b>	The way the body changes food into energy
<b>METHICILLIN-RESISTANT STAPHYLOCOCCUS AUREUS (MRSA)</b>	A bad germ
<b>MICKEY BUTTON</b>	A special cover for the feeding tube site
<b>MIGRAINE</b>	Severe headache
<b>MITRAL VALVE</b>	Tissue that separates the two chambers on the left side of the heart
<b>MITROCHONDIAL DISORDER</b>	A condition when the cells in the body cannot make energy
<b>MOHS SURGERY</b>	A special surgery to remove skin cancer
<b>MOLECULAR BREAST IMAGING (MBI)</b>	A special test to find cancer in the breast
<b>MOLLUSCUM CONTAGIOSUM</b>	A common skin infection that causes raised bumps
<b>MONITORED ANESTHESIA CARE (MAC)</b>	A service used to put a person in a light sleep during a small surgery
<b>MONONEURITIS</b>	Painful swelling of a single nerve
<b>MORBID OBESITY</b>	Being dangerously heavier than normal for one’s height

<b>MOTOR NEURON DISEASE</b>	A group of diseases of the nerves that control muscle movement
<b>MULTIPLE MYELOMA</b>	A type of cancer found in the soft tissue inside the bone
<b>MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS (MS)</b>	A condition when the body attacks the covering of the nerves
<b>MUSCULAR DYSTROPHY</b>	A group of conditions from birth that cause the muscles to weaken
<b>MUTATIONS</b>	Changes that are not normal to the building blocks of cells
<b>MYALGIA</b>	Muscle pain
<b>MYCOTIC TOENAILS</b>	A condition of the toenails caused by a fungus infection
<b>MYELOFIBROSIS</b>	A condition of the soft tissue inside the bone causing blood cells not to form right
<b>MYELOMENINGOCELE</b>	A defect in which the back bones do not close before birth and the spinal cord is exposed
<b>MYELOPATHY</b>	A gradual loss of nerve function due to spinal problems
<b>MYOPATHY</b>	A muscle disease
<b>MYOPIA</b>	A condition when a person can only see close objects clearly
<b>MYOSITIS</b>	Painful swelling of the muscles
<b>MYOTONIC DYSTROPHY</b>	A group of conditions that cause long-lasting muscle stiffness
<b>NARCOLEPSY</b>	A condition causing sudden attacks of sleep during the day
<b>NAUSEA</b>	A sick feeling in the stomach
<b>NEBULIZER</b>	A small machine that turns liquid drugs into a mist to inhale
<b>NEONATAL SCREENING</b>	Tests done to check if a baby has any serious problems
<b>NEOPLASM</b>	A mass of tissue that is not normal
<b>NEPHRECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove the organ that cleans the blood and makes urine
<b>NERVE BLOCK</b>	A shot of medicine that stops pain and feeling to an area of the body
<b>NERVE CONDUCTION STUDY (NCS)</b>	A special test to measure nerve response



<b>NEURAL TUBE DEFECT</b>	A condition from birth due to problems with the brain or spinal cord
<b>NEURALGIA</b>	Nerve pain
<b>NEURITIS</b>	Painful nerve swelling
<b>NEUROBLASTOMA</b>	A type of cancer found in nerve cells
<b>NEUROFIBROMATOSIS</b>	A condition from birth that causes tumors to grow on nerves
<b>NEUROGENIC</b>	Related to a nerve problem
<b>NEUROLOGIC DEFICIT</b>	A condition where the brain and nerves do not work right
<b>NEUROLOGICAL</b>	Related to brain and nerve function
<b>NEUROLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats brain and nerve problems
<b>NEUROMUSCULAR DISEASE</b>	A condition that causes nerve and muscle problems
<b>NEUROPATHY</b>	Pain caused by nerve damage
<b>NEUROPSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING</b>	A group of tests used to study the way a person's brain works
<b>NEUROPSYCHOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who studies how the brain works
<b>NEUROSURGEON</b>	A special doctor who treats the brain and spine
<b>NEUTROPENIA</b>	A lower than normal level of white blood cells
<b>NEVUS</b>	A spot on the skin present at birth
<b>NOCTURIA</b>	A condition of having to urinate at night
<b>NOCTURNAL ENURESIS</b>	A condition of passing of urine while asleep
<b>NOCTURNAL HYPOXIA</b>	A condition of short periods of not breathing while asleep
<b>NODULE</b>	A solid growth of tissue that is not normal
<b>NON-UNION FRACTURE</b>	A broken bone that will not heal
<b>NON-HODGKIN'S LYMPHOMA</b>	A type of cancer when blood has too many white cells
<b>NON-STEROIDAL ANTI-INFLAMMATORY (NSAID)</b>	A group of drugs used to reduce pain and swelling
<b>NUCHAL TRANSLUCENCY TEST</b>	A test to see if an unborn baby has a special problem
<b>NUCLEAR STRESS TEST</b>	A test to measure heart activity after a drug is given

<b>NUMBNESS</b>	Loss of feeling
<b>NUTRITIONAL SUPPLEMENTS</b>	Extra food and vitamins to make the body healthy
<b>NUTRITIONIST</b>	A person who knows about healthy food choices
<b>OBESITY</b>	Being much heavier than normal for one's height
<b>OBSTETRICIAN</b>	A special doctor who treats pregnant women
<b>OBSTRUCTIVE SLEEP APNEA</b>	A condition of short periods of not breathing while asleep
<b>OBSTRUCTIVE SLEEP DISORDER</b>	A condition of short periods of not breathing while asleep
<b>OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY</b>	Treatment to help a person with things they do every day
<b>ONCOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats cancer
<b>ONYCHOMYCOSIS</b>	A condition of the nails caused by a fungus infection
<b>OPEN REDUCTION INTERNAL FIXATION (ORIF)</b>	A surgery to fix a broken bone using hardware
<b>OPHTHALMOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats the eyes
<b>OPIATE DEPENDENCE</b>	A strong need to use heroin-like drugs because a person feels sick and has pain without it
<b>OPTIC NEURITIS</b>	The swelling of the main nerve in the eye
<b>OPTOMETRIST</b>	A special doctor who treats vision problems
<b>ORAL SURGEON</b>	A special doctor who treats teeth and jaw problems
<b>ORBITS</b>	The bones around the eyeball
<b>ORCHIOPEXY</b>	A surgery to move part of the male sex organ into the right place
<b>ORTHOPEDIC SHOES</b>	Special shoes to help fix problems with feet
<b>ORTHOPEDIC SURGEON</b>	A special doctor who treats bone problems
<b>ORTHOPEDIST</b>	A special doctor who treats bone problems
<b>ORTHOTICS</b>	Inserts for the shoes
<b>OSGOOD-SCHLATTER DISEASE</b>	A condition causing painful lumps below the knee in young children
<b>OSTECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove a bone
<b>OSTEOARTHRITIS</b>	A long-term condition causing painful swelling in the joints

<b>OSTEOARTHRISIS</b>	A long-term condition due to wear and tear of the joints
<b>OSTEOCHONDROSIS</b>	A condition causing painful lumps below the knee in young children
<b>OSTEOPENIA</b>	A condition when the bone begins to thin and lose mass
<b>OSTEOPOROSIS</b>	A long-term condition caused by loss of bone mass
<b>OTITIS MEDIA</b>	A condition of swelling in the middle ear
<b>OVARY</b>	A female sex organ that makes and stores egg cells
<b>OXYGEN CONCENTRATOR</b>	A special machine that makes air to breathe
<b>OXYGEN SATURATION</b>	The level of air in blood needed to maintain life
<b>PACEMAKER</b>	A small device placed under the skin that helps the heart beat normally
<b>PALPITATIONS</b>	A condition when the heart beats fast and hard
<b>PANCREAS</b>	An organ that makes chemicals and proteins to help the body break down food
<b>PANCREATITIS</b>	A condition that causes swelling in the organ that helps digest food
<b>PAP SMEAR</b>	A test to check for changes in the lower part of the womb
<b>PARALYSIS</b>	Loss of muscle function in one or more muscles
<b>PARATHYROIDECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove the glands in the neck
<b>PARESTHESIA</b>	A feeling of numbness and tingling on the skin
<b>PARKINSON'S DISEASE</b>	A condition of the brain that leads to shaking and slow movement
<b>PATELLA</b>	The knee cap
<b>PATENT FORAMEN OVALE</b>	A hole in a newborn baby's heart that is not normal
<b>PATHOLOGY REPORT</b>	A list of what was found in tissue removed from the body
<b>PECTUS EXCAVATUM</b>	A condition present from birth where the chest is caved in
<b>PENOSCROTAL FUSION</b>	A condition from birth where the male sex organ is joined to the sac behind it
<b>PEPTIC ULCER DISEASE</b>	The breakdown of the lining in the stomach

<b>PERCUTANEOUS TRANSCATHETER CLOSURE</b>	A surgery to close a hole in the heart
<b>PERICARDITIS</b>	Painful swelling of the sac around the heart
<b>PERINATOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats high risk pregnancies
<b>PERIPHERAL NEUROPATHY</b>	A painful condition of the nerves due to damage or disease
<b>PERIPHERAL VASCULAR DISEASE</b>	A condition of the vessels that carry blood to the legs and feet narrow
<b>PERITONEAL DIALYSIS</b>	A treatment that uses a machine to clean the blood
<b>PERSONAL CARE ITEM</b>	A product used to clean or care for one's own body
<b>PES PLANUS</b>	Flat feet
<b>PESSARY</b>	A plastic device that holds the womb in place
<b>PHIMOSIS</b>	A condition when the foreskin of the male sex organ cannot be pulled back
<b>PHOTODYNAMIC THERAPY</b>	The use of special lights to treat an illness
<b>PHYSICAL THERAPY</b>	Special exercises that will help make the muscles stronger
<b>PHYSIOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENT</b>	The physical growth of a child
<b>PLAGIOCEPHALY</b>	A condition where the skull is flatter on one side than the other
<b>PLANTAR FASCIITIS</b>	A condition of painful swelling of the tissue under the foot
<b>PLANTAR FIBROMATOSIS</b>	A condition where painful bumps grow in the bottom of the foot
<b>PLASMAPHERESIS</b>	A treatment to clean blood
<b>PLASTIC SURGEON</b>	A special doctor who does surgery to change a person's looks
<b>PLATELET</b>	A piece of a blood cell that forms clots to stop bleeding
<b>PLATFORM SWING</b>	A special hanging device to help children with things they feel, see, and hear
<b>PNEUMONIA</b>	A lung infection
<b>PNEUMONITIS</b>	Swelling of the lungs
<b>PNEUMOTHORAX</b>	A collection of air in the space around the lungs
<b>PODIATRIST</b>	A special doctor who treats foot problems

<b>POLIO</b>	An infection that affects nerves and can cause muscles to not work
<b>POLYCYSTIC KIDNEY DISEASE</b>	A condition from birth that causes growths in the organ that cleans the blood and makes urine
<b>POLYCYTHEMIA</b>	A condition of having too many red blood cells
<b>POLYDACTYLY</b>	A condition from birth of having extra toes or fingers
<b>POLYNEUROPATHY</b>	Pain caused by damage to many nerves
<b>POLYSOMNOGRAM STUDY</b>	A test done to see how a person breathes when asleep
<b>POLYURIA</b>	A condition when a person makes too much urine
<b>POSITRON EMISSION TOMOGRAPHY (PET) SCAN</b>	A test that uses a special dye to take a picture of the inside of the body
<b>POST HERPETIC NEUROPATHY</b>	A condition of nerve pain caused by a virus
<b>POST TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER (PTSD)</b>	A condition of high levels of fear and worry from a shocking event
<b>POSTHITIS</b>	A condition of painful swelling on the tip of the male sex organ
<b>POSTURAL DRAINAGE</b>	A treatment to clear the lungs by moving the body in a downward position
<b>POSTURAL HYPOTENSION</b>	Low blood pressure when rising from lying or sitting down
<b>PREMATURE BIRTH</b>	A baby born before 37 weeks of pregnancy
<b>PREMENSTRUAL SYNDROME (PMS)</b>	Mood changes and body pain before a period
<b>PRESSURE ULCER</b>	An open wound from being in one position too long
<b>PRIMARY CILIARY DYSKINESIA</b>	A condition present at birth where hair-like structures in the lungs do not work right
<b>PRIMARY LATERAL SCLEROSIS</b>	A brain disease that causes muscle weakness
<b>PROCTOSIGMOIDOSCOPY</b>	A procedure to look at the inside a small part of the large bowel
<b>PROPHYLACTIC MASTECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove breast tissue to lower the risk of breast cancer
<b>PROSTATITIS</b>	The condition caused by swelling of a male sex organ
<b>PROSTHESIS</b>	A body part made for one person to replace a missing part

<b>PSORIASIS</b>	A condition of red, dry patches of skin
<b>PSORIATIC ARTHRITIS</b>	A condition causing painful joint swelling with red, dry patches of skin
<b>PSYCHIATRIC EVALUATION</b>	A visit with a special doctor to see how a person thinks and feels
<b>PSYCHOLOGICAL TREATMENT</b>	A service to help a person cope with their emotions and thoughts
<b>PTERYGIUM</b>	A growth on the white part of the eye
<b>PULMONARY EMBOLISM</b>	A blood clot in the lungs
<b>PULMONARY FUNCTION TEST</b>	A test to see how well the lungs work
<b>PULMONARY INSUFFICIENCY</b>	A condition where a valve in the heart does not work right
<b>PULMONARY STENOSIS</b>	A condition in which the flow of blood from the heart to the lungs is slowed down
<b>PULSE OXIMETER</b>	A device that measures the gas in blood that maintains life
<b>QUADRIPARESIS</b>	Weakness of both arms and legs
<b>QUADRIPLÉGIA</b>	Inability to use both arms and legs
<b>RACZ PROCEDURE</b>	A procedure to help relieve pain in the spine
<b>RADIATION</b>	A treatment used to kill cancer cells
<b>RADICULITIS</b>	Painful swelling of a nerve
<b>RADICULOPATHY</b>	A group of conditions when one or more nerves do not work right
<b>RADIOALLERGOSORBENT (RAST) TEST</b>	A special blood test to see if a person reacts to something
<b>RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION (RFA)</b>	A treatment used to destroy tissue
<b>RADIOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who looks at pictures of the inside of the body
<b>RAYNAUD'S SYNDROME</b>	A condition that causes parts of the body to become numb and cool
<b>REACTIVE AIRWAY DISEASE (RAD)</b>	A group of conditions that cause problems breathing
<b>RECEPTIVE EXPRESSIVE LANGUAGE DISORDER</b>	A condition that causes problems talking and knowing what is being said
<b>RECTOCELE</b>	When the end of the large bowel bulges into the female sex organ
<b>RECTUM</b>	The end of the large bowel
<b>REDUCTION MAMMOPLASTY</b>	A surgery to make the breasts smaller

<b>REDUNDANT FORESKIN</b>	Extra foreskin on the male sex organ
<b>REFLEX SYMPATHETIC DYSTROPHY (RSD)</b>	A condition that causes painful swelling and skin changes
<b>REFLEX</b>	When the body moves by itself in reaction to something
<b>REHABILITATION</b>	A set of exercises to help the body heal and return to normal
<b>REMISSION</b>	The time when a long-term disease is not active
<b>RENAL FAILURE</b>	A condition when the organs that clean the blood and make urine stop working
<b>REPOSITIONING THERAPY</b>	Turning a sleeping baby often to help reshape the head
<b>RESPIRATORY FAILURE</b>	A condition when the organs that help a person breathe stop working
<b>RESPIRATORY SYNCYTIAL VIRUS (RSV)</b>	A virus that can cause breathing problems in babies and small children
<b>RESPIRATORY SYSTEM</b>	The set of organs that help a person breathe
<b>RESTLESS LEG SYNDROME (RLS)</b>	An urge to move the legs while at rest
<b>RHEUMATOID ARTHRITIS</b>	A long-term condition that causes painful swelling of small joints
<b>RHEUMATOLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats diseases in which a body attacks its own cells
<b>RHINECTOMY</b>	A surgery to remove part of the nose
<b>RHINITIS</b>	Swelling of the airways in the nose
<b>RHINOPLASTY</b>	A surgery to change the shape of the nose
<b>RHIZOTOMY</b>	A surgery to destroy problematic nerves
<b>RANGE OF MOTION (ROM)</b>	The normal way a joint moves
<b>ROSACEA</b>	A long-term condition causing redness and bumps on the face
<b>ROTATOR CUFF</b>	A group of muscles that hold the shoulder in place
<b>SCIATICA</b>	A condition causing pain from the lower back to the leg due to a pinched nerve
<b>SCLERODERMA</b>	A long term skin condition caused by the body attacking its own cells
<b>SCLEROSIS</b>	Hardening of a body part
<b>SCLEROTHERAPY</b>	A treatment used for making swollen veins smaller

<b>SCOLIOSIS</b>	A condition that causes the spine to curve in a way that is not normal
<b>SEAT LIFT MECHANISM</b>	A device that helps a person stand up from a sitting position
<b>SEBORRHEA CAPITIS</b>	A condition causing flaky, white patches of skin on the scalp
<b>SEBORRHEIC DERMATITIS</b>	A condition causing flaky, white patches of skin on the scalp
<b>SEDATION</b>	A condition of being calm and relaxed due to the effect of a drug
<b>SEIZURES</b>	A change in the way a person acts or moves that is not normal due to a brain problem
<b>SENSORY INTEGRATION</b>	A treatment to help a person understand the things they see, feel, hear, taste, and smell
<b>SEPARATION ANXIETY</b>	A condition causing severe stress when being away from the main caregiver
<b>SEPTOPLASTY</b>	A surgery to fix the middle of the nose to help a person breathe better
<b>SHINGLES</b>	An infection from a virus that causes a painful rash with blisters
<b>SHORT STATURE</b>	A condition when a child is much shorter than other children of the same age
<b>SHOWER CHAIR</b>	A chair used to help keep a person safe while they take a shower
<b>SHUNT</b>	A device to drain fluid from an area of the body
<b>SICKLE CELL ANEMIA</b>	A condition from birth causing too many red blood cells that are not normal
<b>SIMPLY THICK</b>	A brand of powder used to make liquids more solid
<b>SINGLE PHOTON EMISSION COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY (SPECT) SCAN</b>	A special kind of picture that measures blood flow to organs or tissue
<b>SINUSITIS</b>	A condition of swelling in the air spaces in the skull
<b>SKIN TAG</b>	A small piece of extra tissue that grows on the body
<b>SLEEP APNEA</b>	A condition that causes a person to stop breathing when asleep
<b>SLEEP DISORDER</b>	A condition that causes a person to have trouble sleeping



<b>SLEEP STUDY</b>	A test done to see how a person breathes when asleep
<b>SLING OPERATION</b>	A surgery to keep the bladder in place
<b>SMARTVEST AIRWAY CLEARANCE SYSTEM</b>	A brand of device that helps clear the lungs of extra mucus
<b>SPASM</b>	The sudden tightening of a muscle that cannot be controlled
<b>SPASTIC</b>	A burst of muscle activity that cannot be controlled
<b>SPEECH DELAY</b>	A condition when a child cannot speak like children of the same age
<b>SPEECH THERAPY</b>	A service to help a person talk better
<b>SPINA BIFIDA</b>	A condition from birth due to problems with the brain or spinal cord
<b>SPINAL CORD STIMULATOR</b>	A device placed near the backbone used to treat long-term pain
<b>SPINAL STENOSIS</b>	Narrowing of the area that holds the spinal cord
<b>SPIROMETRY</b>	A test to see how well the lungs work
<b>SPONDYLOLISTHESIS</b>	A condition where one backbone is out of place
<b>SPONDYLOSIS</b>	Wear and tear of the backbone
<b>STEATOHEPATITIS</b>	A condition caused by too much fat in the liver
<b>STENOSIS</b>	A blood vessel or other body part that is too narrow to work right
<b>STENT</b>	A tiny tube placed in a blood vessel or duct to keep it open
<b>STRABISUMUS</b>	A condition that causes the eyes to be crossed
<b>STRESS INCONTINENCE</b>	A condition when urine leaks while coughing or moving around
<b>STRESS TEST</b>	A test used to evaluate blood flow to the heart during exercise
<b>SUBLUXATION</b>	A condition caused by a bone being out of place
<b>SUPPORT HOSE</b>	Special stockings
<b>SUPRAVENTRICULAR TACHYCARDIA (SVT)</b>	A condition that causes the heart to beat dangerously fast
<b>SWEAT CHLORIDE TEST</b>	A blood test to check for a lung problem causing thick mucus
<b>SYNCOPE</b>	Fainting

<b>TACHYCARDIA</b>	A heartbeat that is faster than normal
<b>TALIPES VALGUS</b>	A condition when the inner side of the foot rests on the ground
<b>TEMPOROMANDIBULAR JOINT (TMJ) DISORDER</b>	A group of conditions that cause pain in the jaw
<b>TENDON</b>	Tissue that connects muscle to bone
<b>TENDONITIS</b>	A condition caused by swelling of the tissue that connects muscle to bone
<b>TETRALOGY OF FALLOT</b>	A group of four types of heart problems present at birth
<b>THORACOSCOPY</b>	A procedure to look inside the chest using a special camera
<b>THORACOTOMY</b>	A surgery to cut into the chest wall
<b>THROMBOCYTOPENIA</b>	A condition when the blood has too few pieces of blood cells to form clots and stop bleeding
<b>THYROID</b>	A gland in the neck that makes chemicals the body needs to work right
<b>THYROIDECTOMY</b>	A surgery to take out the neck gland that makes chemicals which the body needs to work right
<b>TINEA CORPORIS</b>	Ringworm
<b>TINEA PEDIS</b>	Athlete's foot
<b>TINEA VESICOLOR</b>	A condition caused by a skin infection
<b>TINNITUS</b>	A ringing sound in the ears
<b>TONSIL</b>	Tissue at the back of the throat that helps fight infection
<b>TONSILLECTOMY</b>	A surgery to take out the tissue at the back of the throat that helps fight infection
<b>TONSILLITIS</b>	Swelling of the tissue at the back of the throat that helps fight infection
<b>TORSION DYSTONIA</b>	Painful twisting and tightening of muscles
<b>TOTAL PARENTERAL NUTRITION (TPN)</b>	A liquid given through a blood vessel to replace food
<b>TRACHEA</b>	Windpipe
<b>TRACHEAL SUCTION CATHETER</b>	A device used to remove mucus from the windpipe
<b>TRACHEOSTOMY</b>	A surgery to make an opening through the neck into the windpipe

<b>TRACHEOSTOMY SPEAKING VALVES</b>	A device used to help a person talk
<b>TRACTION</b>	The use of steady pulling force to treat muscle and bone problems
<b>TRANSISCHEMIC ATTACK (TIA)</b>	Small stroke
<b>TRANSCUTANEOUS ELECTRICAL NERVE STIMULATION (TENS) UNIT</b>	A device that uses an electric current to block pain
<b>TRANSFER BENCH</b>	A device used to help a person get in and out of a bathtub or shower
<b>TRANSESOPHAGEAL ECHOCARDIOGRAM (TEE)</b>	A test where pictures are taken of the heart through the food pipe
<b>TRANSSEXUALISM</b>	A condition where a person wants to be the other gender
<b>TRAPEZE BAR</b>	A device over a bed that helps a person to sit up or move around
<b>TREMOR</b>	Twitching of one or more parts of the body
<b>TRIGGER POINTS</b>	Muscle knots that cause pain
<b>TRIGLYCERIDE</b>	A type of fat in blood
<b>TUBAL LIGATION</b>	A surgery to stop pregnancy
<b>TUMOR</b>	A growth
<b>TURBINATE REDUCTION</b>	A surgery to the nasal airways to help a person breathe better
<b>TYMPANOMETRY</b>	A test to check for fluid in the middle ear
<b>TYMPANOSTOMY</b>	A surgery to place tubes inside the eardrum to drain fluid from the middle ear
<b>ULCERATIVE COLITIS</b>	A long-term condition of the bowel causing painful swelling and sores
<b>ULTRASOUND</b>	A special picture of the inside the body using sound waves
<b>UPPER GASTROINTESTINAL SERIES</b>	A group of tests that look at the inside of the body from the food pipe to the small bowel
<b>URETHRA</b>	A tube in the body that drains urine from the bladder
<b>URINARY OBSTRUCTION</b>	A condition when the urine flow is blocked
<b>URINARY TRACT INFECTION (UTI)</b>	A condition caused by germs in the body parts that make and empty urine
<b>URODYNAMIC TESTING</b>	A test that checks how well the bladder holds and empties urine

<b>UROLOGIST</b>	A special doctor who treats the body parts that make and empty urine
<b>URTICARIA</b>	A rash
<b>UTERINE ACTIVITY MONITOR</b>	A device used to measure the movement of the baby in the womb
<b>UTERINE FIBROIDS</b>	Growths inside the womb that are not normal
<b>UTERUS</b>	Womb
<b>VALGUS</b>	A bone turned outward
<b>VARICOSE VEINS</b>	Blood vessels that are twisted and swollen
<b>VARUS</b>	A bone turned inward
<b>VASCULITIS</b>	A condition due to swelling of a blood vessel
<b>VASECTOMY</b>	A surgery on the male sex organ to prevent pregnancy
<b>VENOUS INSUFFICIENCY</b>	A condition when the blood vessels in the legs cannot return blood to the heart
<b>VENTRICULAR SEPTAL DEFECT (VSD)</b>	A hole in the heart that is not normal
<b>VERTEBROPLASTY</b>	A procedure to fix a broken backbone
<b>VERTIGO</b>	Dizziness
<b>VESICoureTERAL REFLUX</b>	A condition when urine flows back into the kidneys
<b>VEST AIRWAY CLEARANCE SYSTEM</b>	A device that helps clear the lungs of extra mucus
<b>VESTIBULAR CUDDLE SWING</b>	A special hanging device to help children to have better balance
<b>VESTIBULAR PHYSICAL THERAPY</b>	Special exercises that help a person have better balance
<b>VIDEO CAPSULE ENDOSCOPY</b>	A test using a small camera which is swallowed to look inside the body
<b>VITILIGO</b>	A condition in which the skin loses color causing white patches
<b>VOIDING CYSToureTHROGRAM (VCUG)</b>	A special picture of the bladder while a person urinates
<b>VON WILLEBRAND DISEASE</b>	A condition present from birth that causes bleeding that is not normal
<b>WALKER</b>	A metal, four-legged frame to help a person walk safely
<b>WEIGHTED VEST</b>	A type of clothing used to help a child calm down and learn better

<b>WHEELCHAIR--HEAVY DUTY</b>	A wheeled device for people that weigh over 250 pounds
<b>WHEELCHAIR--POWER</b>	A wheeled device with a motor that lets a person move around
<b>WHEELCHAIR--STANDARD MANUAL</b>	A device that lets a person move around while turning the wheels by hand
<b>WHEEZING</b>	A whistling sound during breathing caused by mucus
<b>WOUND VAC</b>	A special device that helps heal a large area of skin that has been cut or torn
<b>XANTHELASMA</b>	A condition that causes yellow bumps around the eyes
<b>X-RAY</b>	A special picture of the inside of the body
<b>YEAST INFECTION</b>	A condition caused by a fungus
